3 Give further details about why you want to meet them.

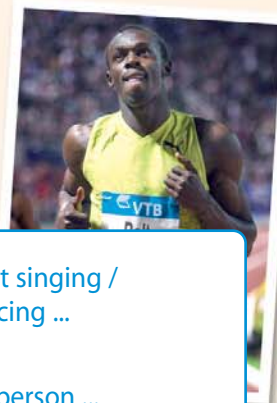
